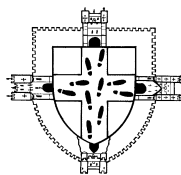

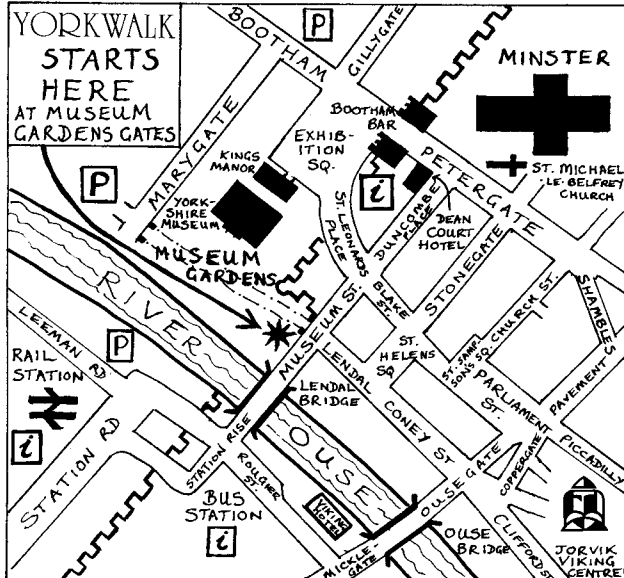

- No need to book - just turn up on the day

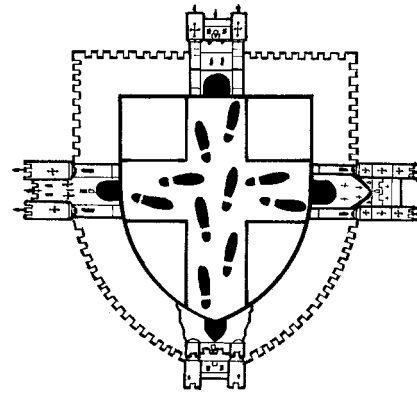
Persons under 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

- This is right next to the Park & Ride stop from Rawcliffe Bar; 3 minutes from bus stops in Exhibition Square and Rougier St; 5 minutes walk from York Railway station or the long stay car park in Marygate.
- Option of a short break for refreshments in historic surroundings. All walks guaranteed departures, come rain or shine. Minimum group size 2.

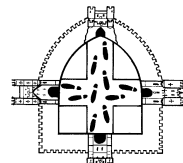

Special Walks - 2009

Bloody Execution Tour
See Turrets where heads were impaled on spikes; hear of Dick Turpin's last hours, public hangings, floggings, brandings and duckings.
Choccy & Sweetie Tour +*
York has played a big part in pleasing the sweet tooth. Hear the history of Terry's, Rowntree's & Cravens. See sweets being made, and taste some delicious samples!
Jewish Heritage Trail
Visit historic Jewish sites in York; the first tour is near the anniversary of the dreadful massacre of the Jews at Clifford's Tower.

Inaccessible and Hidden York *
A unique chance to enter parts of York never open to the public; to descend into cellars and Roman remains, and explore secret passages, crypts, mediaeval churches & hidden Georgian interiors. Shown in **BOLD** in list of walks.
The Graveyard, Coffin and Crypt Tour *
Visit the hidden city of the dead; descend to a secret crypt, sample Roman and mediaeval coffins and visit plague sites.
How the Minster was Built Ø +
A fascinating tour to see how this great church was built by the mediaeval masons, with a glimpse of the modern stonemard.
Historic Toilet Tour
A saga of convenience from Roman hygiene to 19th C attempts to prevent 'nuisance' and promote public decency. Also sample the dubious comforts of mediaeval garderobes!

The Battle of Fulford Walk *
A gentle 3 mile walk to the battle site near the anniversary of the Battle of Fulford, the forgotten battle of 1066. Option of a pub lunch. Return to York by bus. Stout footwear recommended.
Henry VIII Trail (NEW)* +
Henry VIII ascended to the throne 500 years ago this year. In 1541, he made a state visit to York, obese, diseased and constipated. Follow in his footsteps and see the havoc he wrought on the monasteries and hospitals.

Richard III Trail
Follow in the footsteps of this much maligned monarch, still revered in York; at the end visit the Richard III museum.
Historic Inns & Pubs Tour + (Adults only)
Relax after a day's sightseeing on a stroll round York's most historic & picturesque hostellers, all with colourful stories.
Guy Fawkes Trail
Explore the (several!) birthplaces and haunts of one of York's most infamous sons - Guy Fawkes of Gunpowder Plot fame.
St. Nicholas Tour Ø +
A fascinating Yuletide look in York Minster at the life and legends of St. Nicholas - the origin of Santa Claus.
